

Internal Quality Assurance Cell(IQAC)

Report of the Seven-day online Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on Redefining-Teaching Learning with the Integration of ICT from 01.07.2020 to 04.07.2020 and 06.07.2020 to 08.07.2020.

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Holy Cross College (Autonomous) Nagercoil organized a Seven-day online Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on Redefining-Teaching Learning with the Integration of ICT from 01.07.2020 to 04.07.2020 and 06.07.2020 to 08.07.2020. The timing is from 10 a.m to 11.30 a.m on the first four days and from 3 p.m to 4.30 p.m on the last three days. On the first day of the FDP, Dr. H. Jimsy Asha, the IQAC Co-ordinator, Assistant Professor of English began the session with the prayer song video followed by a brief history of the IQAC of Holy Cross College, Nagercoil. Dr. Sr. S. Sahaya Selvi, Assistant Professor of Commerce welcomed the delegates, invited speaker and the participants of the FDP. Dr. Sr. Gerardin Jayam, the Secretary of our college offered felicitation. Dr. Sr. Anne Perpet Sophy, our Principal encouraged with her words of appreciation. Dr. H. Jimsy Asha gave the necessary instructions to the participants. Mr. A. Vimal Jerald M.C.A., NET, M.Phil., MBA., (Ph.D), Assistant Professor of Computer Science, St. Joseph's College (Autonomous), Trichy was the resource person for this FDP programme.






The resource person started the first day session emphasizing the need, importance and scope of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) enabled teaching in today's scenario. He gave an orientation on ICT based Teaching Learning and Evaluation (TLE), Learning Management Systems. He highlighted that teachers should be familiar with ICT enabled TLE platforms which in turn would redesign higher education. He also informed on the MHRD and UGC initiatives in facilitating online TLE. A live demonstration on creating classes, assignments and online tests, uploading materials and evaluation management using EDMODO was given by the resource person. An assignment was given to the participants on the same and the participants are asked to submit it in Google Classroom. An online quiz link was shared in the chat box for the participants of the FDP. Doubts were clarified in a systematic manner. Dr. A. Anami Augustus Arul, Assistant Professor of Botany moderated the questions of the fellow participants. Dr. H. Jimsy Asha proposed the vote of thanks.

On the second day of the FDP, Dr. A. Anami Augustus Arul welcomed the host and the participants followed by the instructions. Mr. Vimal Jerald made a demo on the Socrative tool, creation of teacher account, test, quiz and evaluation. He further explained the applications of Classroom Screen and to create GIF animation using EZGif. An assignment was given on the same. Dr. A. Anami Augustus Arul thanked the resource person and moderated the queries. Dr. H. Jimsy Asha made a reminder on the assignments in Google Classroom, quiz links and attendance. On the third day of the FDP, Dr. S. Sujitha, Assistant Professor of Mathematics

welcomed the gathering. The resource person began the session by introducing SLIDO and thereby got the feedback of the previous sessions. He clearly explained the creation of personal profile using Google Sites. Then he made a demo on designing posters, invitations



and brochures using the tool Canva. Dr. S. Sujitha thanked the resource person and moderated the queries.

On the fourth day, Dr. S. Ajith Sinthuja, Assistant Professor of Chemistry welcomed the gathering. Mr. Vimal Jerald made a demo on designing certificates and videos using Canva. Then he explained on the different types of E-content and demonstrated the text based E-content using MS-Word and interactive PPT E-content. Ms. J. Alisha Josephine, Assistant Professor of English moderated the questions raised by the fellow participants. Dr. H. Jimsy Asha thanked the gathering followed by the reminders.

On the fifth day of the webinar, Dr. Sr. S. Sahaya Selvi welcomed the gathering. Mr.Vimal Jerald made a live demo on creating videos using Renderforest and Screencast-O-Matic tools. 



Following this speech, the participants also asked the questions & queries on prevention of coronavirus. Thus, the sessionbecame very interactive, useful and informative.



Report of the Student Induction Programme
